

ANTRIM COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION

UNIFORM MAILBOX POLICY

From time to time, mailboxes become damaged during Road Commission activities (i.e. snow plowing, roadside mowing, etc.). When such damage occurs, it should be reported to the Road Commission. Road Commission personnel will inspect said mailbox as soon as time and weather permit.

If the Road Commission's inspection of the damaged mail box indicates the damage was caused by their equipment actually coming into contact with the mailbox, the Road Commission will replace the mailbox and post (if necessary) as soon as time and weather permit, except that the Road Commission will not replace mailboxes that have become covered by snow. Also, the Road Commission will not replace mailboxes or posts damaged by the impact of snow and/or ice being plowed from the roadway.

Replacement mailboxes and posts shall be the standard types carried in inventory by the Road Commission regardless of the type and size of the original.
