

The Board of Road Commissioners for the County of Antrim met at the County Garage, Mancelona, Michigan for a regular meeting at 9:30 a.m.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Hoogerhyde.

Present: Commissioners Amos, Giar and Hoogerhyde. Also present: Engineer-Manager Thompson and Secretary Farrier.

It was moved by Giar and seconded by Amos to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried by unanimous yes vote.

It was moved by Giar and seconded by Amos to approve the April 20, 2021 regular meeting minutes. Motion carried by unanimous yes vote.

At 9:33 the floor was opened for public comment.

BOC Liaison Rubingh stated he has been receiving complaints of dusty roads.

Being no further comment, the floor returned to the Chair at 9:35 a.m.

Road Commission correspondence was discussed.

2021 Cashflow, MTF and Fund balance reports were reviewed.

The Engineer-Manager gave his report.

The Engineer-Manager discussed with the Board a request from Mr. Jeff Rauschenberg to re-certify 0.15 mile of Richardson Road in Chestonia Township, east from the current certification of 0.37 from Corey Road. The Road Commission de-certified 0.63 mile of Richardson Rd west from Cinder Hill Road in 1971, essentially landlocking his property. In 1933, the Road Commission took over 1.0 mile of road between Cinder Hill Road and Corey Road from Chestonia Township. It was not abandoned, so the public right-of-way still exists.

It was moved by Giar and seconded by Amos to re-certify as a county seasonal road part of Richardson Road, starting at 0.37 mile east of Corey Road, thence east 0.15 mile along the section-line common to sections 25 & 36 of Chestonia Township, T30N, R6W. Motion carried by unanimous yes vote.

The Board discussed a petition requesting abandonment of unused deeded right-of-way, 225' long and 33' wide, off of Six Mile Lake Road, Section 5, Echo Township.

Resolution #2021-05 was offered by Giar with support of Amos, to-wit:

WHEREAS, the following described road right-of-way under control of the Antrim County Road Commission; and

WHEREAS, the right-of-way herein described is for public road purposes; and

WHEREAS, all property owners abutting these rights-of-way have, by petition, requested their abandonment; and

WHEREAS, there are no buildings of character on said sections of road; and

WHEREAS, the herein described road right-of-way is, by this resolution, removed from the local road system of Antrim County; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following described road right-of-way be abandoned:

Resolution #2021-05 continued:

Part of Government Lot 4 of Section 5 Township 31 North Range 7 West, Echo Township, Antrim County, Michigan described as follows:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of said Section 5 thence North 00° 29' 27" E along the Section line common to Sections 5 and 6 a distance of 428.15 feet (recorded as 375 feet and 428.73 feet); thence South 89° 30' 14" East 26.27 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING of this description; thence Northwesterly along a 1107.74 foot radius curve to the left an arc distance of 132.17 feet (long chord bears North 10° 57' 33" West 132.09 feet) said curve being along the East line Six Mile Lake Road; thence North 00° 29' 27" East along the Section line 96.34 feet to an iron rod; thence South 88° 00' 00" East 33.00 feet to an iron rod; thence South 00° 29' 27" West 225.00 feet to an iron rod; thence North 89° 30' 14" West 6.75 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Ayes: Commissioners Amos, Giar and Hoogerhyde. Nays: none. Absent: none.


Resolution #2021-05 declared adopted.

It was moved by Giar and seconded by Amos that the request for reimbursement in the amount of \$10,000.00 for services of a licensed professional engineer for the period July 1, 2020 thru June 30, 2021 as allowed by Act 51, of 1951, as amended, be signed. Motion carried by unanimous yes vote. The request was so signed.

The 2020 Act 51 Annual Report was reviewed. It was moved by Amos and seconded by Giar to accept the 2020 Act 51 report, as presented, and authorize the Chairman, Godfrey Hoogerhyde, to sign it. Motion carried by unanimous yes vote. The report was so signed.

Bills in the amount of \$355,204.55 covered by master voucher(s) #08A, #09 & #10 and payroll(s) #09 & #10 in the amount of \$153,866.28 were reviewed.
