The Board of Road Commissioners for the County of Antrim met at the Road Commission Office, Mancelona, Michigan for a regular meeting at 9:30 a.m.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Hoogerhyde.

Present: Commissioners Amos, Giar and Hoogerhyde. Absent: none. Also present: Engineer-Manager Thompson, Accounting Manager Harp and Secretary Sexton.

Motion by Giar, to approve the agenda as presented. Second by Amos. Motion carried by unanimous yes vote.

Motion by Amos, to approve February 21, 2023 regular meeting minutes. Second by Giar. Motion carried by unanimous yes vote.

The floor was opened for public comment at 9:31 a.m.

Several residents from Lakeshore Dr spoke about their concern with the road.

Tom Richards, presented a letter he wrote and read aloud concerning Lake shore dr.

Rollin Gish, voiced his concern with moving Lakeshore Dr and impact on property.

Pricilla Gish, voiced her concern with erosion.

Diane Jensen, moving road will impact septic system.

Jon Smalley, safety concern for property owners.

Mark Lame and Kathy Lame, voiced their concern with moving road for safety.

Alex Busman - Banks Township Supervisor, inquired about what the Township can do to help. Township is interested in relocating road further away from slope.

The Engineer-Manager gave a brief history of the road. It was once proposed to the Antrim County Road Commission by Wayne Boss, one time property owner on Lakeshore Dr., to relocate the road behind Gish's house. This was resoundingly objected to by many property owners. Reasons stated at the time included, but not limited to: No safety concern near the slope; the road is a scenic road traveled by many tourists viewing the lake and the view would be ruined: would negatively impact the wetlands. Many paving estimates have been provided to the Township over the years. Antrim County Road Commission's long-standing policy will not pay for new pavement and the Township has not been in favor of paying the cost. Width of pavement has changed due to State Law requiring strict use of guidelines as standards. Engineer-Manager indicated that once weather breaks, a new location for road will be staked out for affected property owners to review it. It may be difficult getting new easements from property owners due to proposed road alignment cutting through buildable lots. He also indicated that a preliminary estimate to relocate road further away from slope would be around \$250,000.00.

There being no further comments, the floor returned to the Chair at 11:10 a.m.

Several pieces of correspondence were reviewed.

2023 Cash flow, MTF and fund balance were discussed.

The Engineer-Manager gave his report.

Service requests were reviewed.

The list of 2023 projects were reviewed.

Update on Pinney Bridge Road snowmobile trail was given.

Mineral well brine proposed regulations were discussed. The EGLE has indicated that they will not implement new regulations on April 1, 2023.
